GOOD READ BUT....By The realskinny This is a pretty good read with several pointers; however, like many experiential books it suffers from a lack of various perspectives and from more in depth how to information. Of note and what should be of keen interest to anyone considering buying land or homesteading----- especially buying land in the Ozarks are soil composition and AMOUNT of soil. If you have the wrong soil types you either will be trucking in soil, compost, humus, and manure and amendments and building raised beds for your plants (with probable limited plant production after freezing weather) or you will be waiting about a hundred years or so for the soil to do that work for you. The fact is much of the OZARK land available is not only very rocky, the bedrock may be as little as 4 inches underneath the soil. Things to look for are: 1. Stunted grass or sparse grass 2. Rocky outcrops 3. cedars growing with no hardwood trees 4. exposed rocks or lots of rocky gravel. Why does this matter? A. Because it is almost impossible to dig soil or there may be very little soil for a garden B. fence post digging which you may need to create safe places for domestic animals may require heavy duty equipment like hydraulic post hole augers--added expense to have someone do this .C. Water. We need storage for this. The cost to dig ponds, septic, and potential cisterns, or leach fields are much higher when rock as to be blasted. D. More rock often means little to no clay for building or sealing a pond which means soil trucked in for creating a dam, often pond liners must be used which give a much shorter pond life before repair. No matter where a person lives or how much well, lake, or spring water access they have, a private, holding water source is advisable because slant drilling, imminent domain issues and community sharing or diversion of water resources can quickly change your water fortune. These things and more are often the reality in the OZARKS, though not always. But it is more often true than not and IMO should be in any homestead book. Most people who elect to read about off grid are not looking for entertaining reading but to garner information prior to them making decisions.
